In 2001, NJ TRANSIT was finalizing the design for its Ramsey Route 17 rail station. As NJ TRANSIT's Chief Designer, CESAR VERGARA was responsible for the "look and feel" of all rolling stock, infrastructure, stations and furnishings. He proposed modifying the station design with a series of perforated metal panels to unify the station façade and parking garage. These ideas were incorporated and improved the look of the structure.
